Jean-Paul returned to Bukavu at the end of August from six months study in a Protestant Theological College in Montpellier southern France. The study leave was to allow him supervised study time to work on his PhD thesis. Although his place was sponsored by another Christian charity EWM UK was able to contribute towards his living costs.



Jean-Paul writes:

Receive our greetings in Jesus Christ' name.

I am so thankful to God for his protection of me with my family and all his people who we serve as Eagle Wings Ministry in D.R. Congo. (established by Jean-Paul, totally independent of EWM UK but with whom we are in fellowship).

I thank God for enabling me to organise two conferences in Bukavu on September 23th-26th and October 19th.

The September conference of one day gathered 114 Pastors from different churches and we discussed forgiveness.

On October 5th, I gathered 38 youths to discuss spiritual gifts.

On Saturday, October 19th we gathered 100 Christian couples and talked about 'Reducing Domestic Violence in Christian families'. This topic was chosen by the participants because there are many problems in Christian families where husbands and wives are tempted to divorce. I am called to do the same conference for 70 Christian couples in Goma on Tuesday October 21st.

So, since I have been back from France in early September God has enabled EWM to have served a total of 378 people including pastors and lay people. I praise the Lord for that. Next Tuesday, we will be gathering another 140 people at St. Paul's Cathedral of the Anglican Diocese of Goma.
